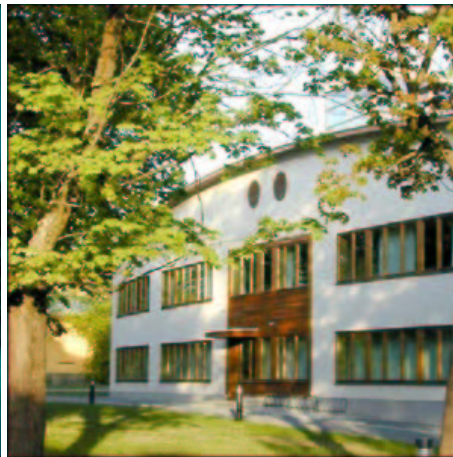


# Quick guide to: 2nd Scandinavian Neutrino Workshop (SNOW 2006)

AlbaNova University Center, Stockholm, Sweden

May 2-6, 2006

## How to get to SNOW 2006

### Hotel to workshop

In Fig. 1, we have marked the location of the AlbaNova University Center along with the locations of the hotels and the routes of relevant bus lines as well as the subway exit closest to AlbaNova. For information on bus and subway tickets, please see the SL homepage <http://www.sl.se/english>. All hotels are also within proper walking distance from AlbaNova if you prefer to go to the workshop on foot.

### Airport to Stockholm central station

The main airport of Stockholm is Stockholm-Arlanda Airport, situated approximately three quarters of an hour from Stockholm by car. In order to get from Arlanda to Stockholm, you can either take an airport bus (a one-way trip costs 89 SEK per person and a round trip costs 170 SEK per person, 40 min) or the Arlanda Express train (a one-way trip costs 190 SEK per person and a round trip costs 360 SEK per person, 20 min) to get to the Stockholm Central station from where you can go by subway to your hotel. Alternatively you can get a taxi which will take you directly to your hotel.

From the other airports related to Stockholm (Bromma, Skavsta, and Västerås), there are airport buses leaving on a more or less regular basis, see <http://www.flygbussarna.se/en/> for details.

### Stockholm central station to hotels

If you want to travel by public transportation from the central station to your hotel, then the best way is to use the subway system. If you will be staying at Hotel Arcadia, then you should take the red line to "Tekniska högskolan" and use the exit towards "Körsbärsvägen". The hotel is only a short walk from this exit.

In order to get to Vanadis Hotel & Bath, take the green line to "Rådmanngatan" and then walk north along "Sveavägen" until you reach the hotel.

For the other two hotels, take the green line to “Odenplan”. The hotels are both situated close to the station exit.

## **Facilities**

### **Lecture hall**

The talks of the workshop will be held in the Oskar Klein auditorium at the AlbaNova University Center. The auditorium has been named after the Swedish physicist Oskar Klein (1894-1977). He was a professor in theoretical physics at Stockholm University between 1931 and 1962. He is best known for the Klein-Gordon equation and for his attempts to unify electromagnetism and general relativity by the introduction of extra dimensions, known as Kaluza-Klein theory.

The Oskar Klein auditorium is equipped with projectors to which your laptop can be connected for your presentation, as well as transparency projectors. There will also be a local laptop available for presentations if you do not wish to bring your own. If you want to make use of the local laptop, please bring your presentation on a USB memory stick or send it to [snow2006@physics.kth.se](mailto:snow2006@physics.kth.se). The file formats supported on the local laptop will be PDF, PS, and PPT.

### **Internet connection**

The AlbaNova University Center is equipped with a fully developed wireless network to which the participants of SNOW 2006 will have access. There will be no cable connections or public computers.

## **Talk procedure**

In order for the workshop program to proceed smoothly, you should contact the organizers in the break before your talk (or in good time before the session start if you have a talk in the first session of the day) in order to check that your laptop works well together with the projectors or that your presentation displays in a satisfactory way if you will be using the local laptop.

## **Lunches**

The lunches, which are included in the workshop fee, will be served at “Restaurang Entré” on level 3 of the AlbaNova University Center (one level below the Oskar Klein lecture hall). Lunch tickets will be included in your workshop kit, which you will receive upon registration. There have been tables reserved outside just outside the main seating area.

## **Welcome reception at the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences**

On the evening of May 2, there will be a welcome reception at the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences. There will be a bus leaving from AlbaNova at 18.00 which will take us to the academy. If you wish to go to the academy by yourself, then take the red subway line to “Universitetet” (one stop from “Tekniska högskolan”) and follow the signs towards “Kungliga Vetenskapsakademien”. To participate in the welcome reception, you will need to bring the welcome reception ticket, which you will receive upon registration. The welcome reception will start at 18.30 with a guided tour of the academy. At 19.00, a buffet will be served.

## **Excursion**

The excursion starts at 13.30 on May 4, the excursion bus will leave from the AlbaNova at this time. First, we will be transported to the Royal Armory, situated beneath the Royal Palace, where we will participate in a short guided tour. Afterwards, the excursion will continue with a boat trip in the archipelago of Stockholm, starting just outside of the Royal Palace. The excursion will end at 17.15 at the Royal Palace in walking distance from the City Hall of Stockholm. In order to attend the excursion, you will need to bring the excursion ticket, which you will receive upon registration (assuming that you have opted to participate in the excursion).

## **Reception at the City Hall**

The reception at the City Hall will start at 18.00. In order to participate in the reception, you need to bring the City Hall reception ticket, which you will receive upon registration. If you are not going to participate in the excursion, then you can preferably go to the City Hall by subway. The closest subway stop is "Rådhuset" on the blue subway line.

## **Workshop dinner**

The workshop dinner will take place at Häringe castle on May 5. The bus to the castle will leave from Hotel Arcadia at 18.00. On the return trip from the castle, the bus will stop by all the workshop hotels. To participate in the dinner, you need to bring the workshop dinner ticket, which you will receive upon registration (assuming that you have opted to participate in the dinner).
